## Why Do You Go to Remote Villages?

This was a question I was asked as I presented Lydia Circle Ministries to a group of people. Jesus told us that we must go and tell everyone the gospel message. The small villages that we minister to need to know about Jesus, just as much as big cities with big churches.

The women that live in remote villages are very industrious. Notice the picture to the left: the benches are made from mud that was formed, the floor is evened out with mud, and the bricks that make up the painted walls have also been backed with mud. Why is this important to understand? Because these people built this church as a light in this remote village without needing to raise money; they used their own hands to build it immediately.

The women are so excited to be a part of learning how to tell the gospel message and to fill their churches with those who need to be disciplined. For many women, this is the first time they have received any instruction for their spiritual growth!
